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Agriculture is

- 1. The biggest contributor to the loss of global biodiversity ¹
- 2. The leading cause of deforestation²
- 3. Causing up to one-third of our greenhouse gas emissions ³

Wasted Food Fast Facts

- America wastes nearly 40% of all food produced
- the equivalent of throwing 320,000 jumbo jets worth of food directly into the landfill each year⁴
- The average American tosses 300 pounds of food each year⁵
- Wasted Food has doubled since the 1970's⁶
- If land used to grow food that isn't eaten were a country, it would be the second largest country in the world behind Russia

Why do we waste so much food? 8

- Purchasing too much food
- Label confusion (best by, use by, sell by, etc.)
- Lack of knowledge when preparing foods
- Confusion over when food is ripe
- Seasonal factors
- Uneaten leftovers

Why is wasting food an issue?

- Environmental Rotting food in landfills creates Methane gas 28x more potent than CO2 ⁹
- Missed Opportunity to Feed Hungry Neighbors 1 in 7 Americans are food insecure.
 Don't know where their next meal is coming from ¹⁰
- **Economic** -estimated that the average American throws out 23 lbs. of food each month = \$190 for a family of four ¹¹
